Longer Article Format

Microsoft word files. In English. Simple formatting with single line spacing.

Provide full author details including address (used to send a hard copy of printed article). Please place at beginning of article how you would prefer to be cited – name, position, organisation and contact details.

At the end of the article provide with full captions, any illustrations, graphs, tables and photos.

Photography: If using embedded photo images, please supply all photography as high resolution (300dpi) large format TIF or jpeg files. Please feel free to use a cloud based image transfer service if necessary. All images should be free to use and referenced with source if from a third party.

Graphs: Provide in excel format for ease of reproduction.

Length

Please submit or consider articles from 500 up to 2000 words.

For 500 words – accompany with 1 -2 images

For 2000 words – accompany with 4- images

Deadlines

IPC goes to print every two months. The deadline for submission is the end of each two month period for the following issue; i.e. February, April, June, August, October, December.

The Editor reserves the right to amend content, such as changing text to UK English, removing excessive brand or corporate references etc. News items or press releases may be distilled to fit our News in Brief format of 200-240 words.
